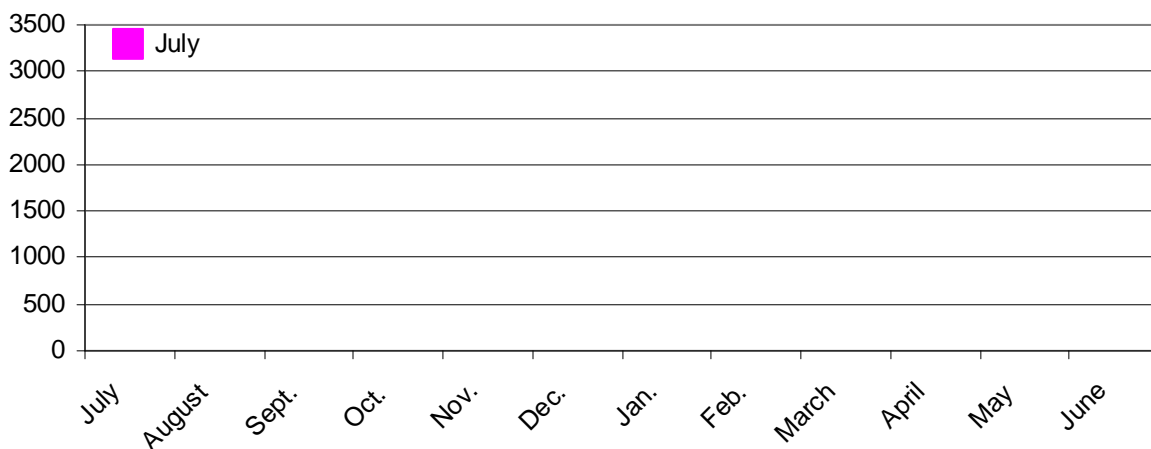
GALILEO

FY 2010 GALILEO DATABASE USAGE



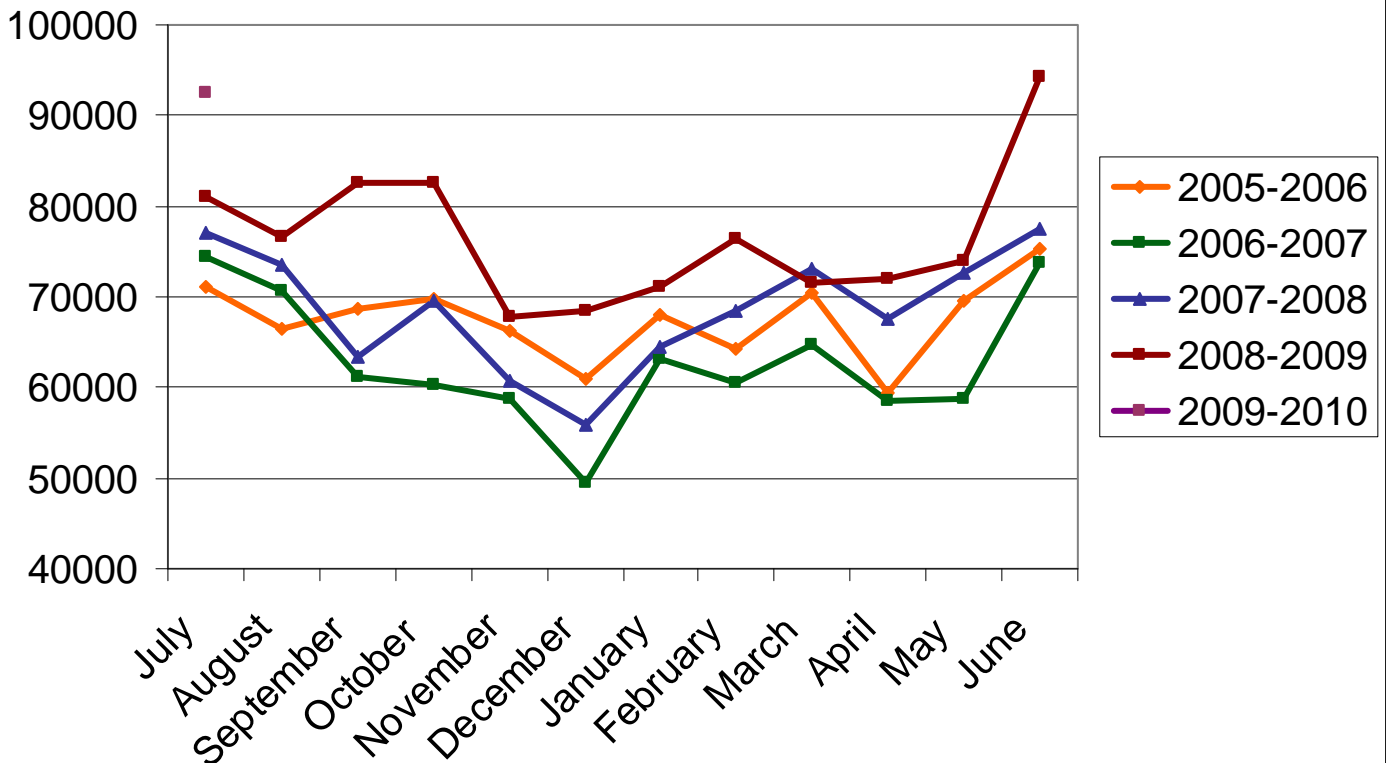
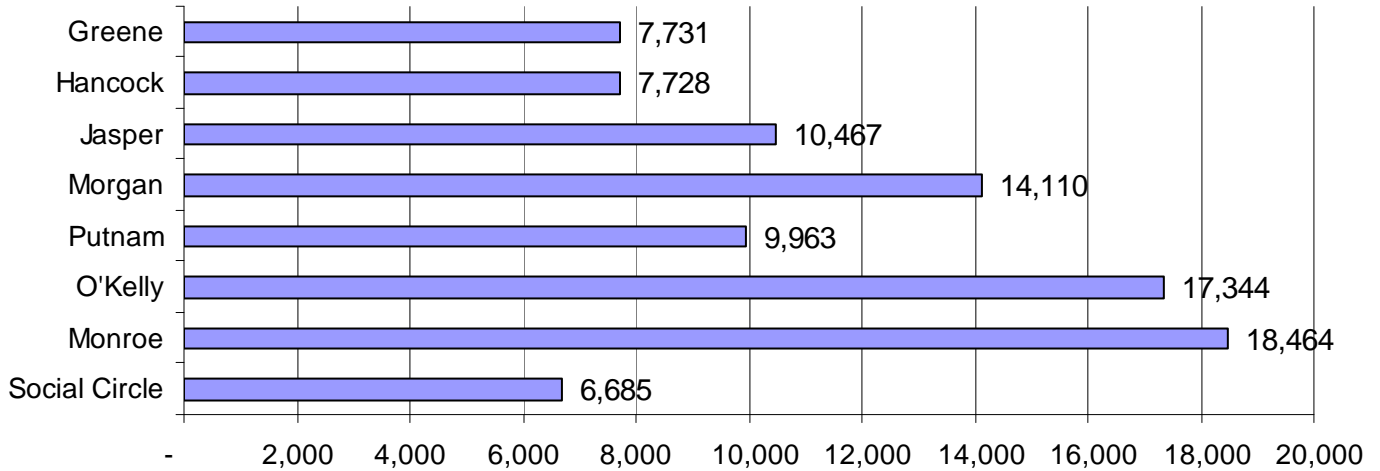
